

ADAMAWA STATE CITIZEN'S ENGAGEMENT TOWN HALL MEETING ON 2021 BUDGET HELD ON 28TH JULY, 2020

TOWN HALL MEETING I:

INTRODUCTION: The citizens' engagement Town hall meeting is aimed at sensitizing stakeholder towards preparing a robust and all-inclusive Budget for 2021. Citizen engagement is a form of interaction between citizen and their government, it can happen at any stage of development or implementation of government policy and triggered by event.

Citizen engagement can lead to a range of outcomes, including more effective services and more responsive and accountable state; therefore, citizens play a critical role in advocating and helping to make public institutions more transparent, accountable and effective and contributing innovative solutions to complex development challenges.

More so it helps government achieve improved development results in creating links between citizen and improved public service delivery, public financial management, governance, social inclusion and empowerment.

In the same vein, citizen engagement, especially during crisis like Covid-19 pandemic as effectiveness of response efforts can often hinge on behaviour change at the micro-level, informing and receiving feedback from citizen can provide insight on how the crisis is affecting communities and enable real-time correction in evolving situation as well as post-crisis.

The Town hall meeting was organized by the Adamawa State Planning Commission (ASPC) and Chaired by the Executive Chairman Planning Commission Dr. Mary Paninga. The meeting was attended by cross section of stakeholders including Local Government officials, Civil Society Organization (CSOs) Woman and Youth Leaders, Community Leaders, religious leaders, representatives of people living with disabilities etc. within the State.

OPENING REMARKS:

The Executive Chairman State Planning Commission; Dr. Mary Panínga gave the welcome address. In her remarks, she commended the turnout of participants and highlighted the objectives of the citizens' engagement which according to her are to enable the citizens understand the budget process, to abreast them on how public funds are generated and utilized, to gather citizen's inputs for inclusion into the 2021 Budget, to create synergy between the citizens and the government for good governance amongst others. She also stressed the need for all the Stakeholders including Civil Society Organizations bodies to give their inputs and make necessary suggestions and positive criticisms that will enable ASPC prepare an all-inclusive Budget.

She was optimistic that the engagement with citizens will provide solutions to some of the problems and challenges being faced by the Citizens. The Executive Chairman also emphasized that the engagement meeting will help the Government identify the prioritized needs of its citizens for inclusion into the 2021 Budget.

GOODWILL MESSAGES:

The elder state men from the various Local Government Areas applauded the initiative by the State Government to engage its citizen in the Budget process. They also re-iterated their continuous support to always participate in such an event so as to always voice out their most pressing problems.

PRESENTATION

The Director Budget, Mr. Adamu Yakubu Briefed the meeting on the importance of citizen's participation in the Budget process. He said time has moved from Government deciding for the people to ensuring that Budget reflects what the Citizens want. This forum is necessary for Government to listen to your needs, priorities and plan the Budget to reflect these needs and priorities. Further on his presentation, he highlighted the following Budget processes:

- i. Citizen Engagement Town hall meeting
- ii. Call circular for the submission of proposed Budget by MDAs
- iii. Bi- lateral Discussion with MDAs and CSOs
- iv. Submission of the draft proposed Budget to EXCO for deliberation
- v. Submission of proposed Budget to State House of Assembly by His Excellency the Executive Governor.
- vi. House of Assembly meetings with MDAs and passing of bill
- vii. Governor's Assent.

The citizens' engagement was carried out in the Senatorial zones of the State namely Yola North, Yola South, Fufore, Girei, Song, Gombi and Hong LGAs. From the deliberations with the citizens, the following priorities were identified:

1. Construction of Gombi-Gaánda road
2. Rehabilitation of Healthcare centres facilities in all the LGAs in the Central Zones
3. Provision of cattle route from Gombi to Guyaku in Garkida
4. Provision of designated waste disposal area in Jimeta Yola North
5. Rehabilitation and furnishing of Public Secondary Schools in all the LGAs in the Central Senatorial Zone
6. Construction of storm water drainage in Jimeta and Yola
7. Construction of a standard stadium in the State Capital
8. Provision of Scholarship to students
9. Construction of skill acquisition centres
10. Dilling of bore-holes in Banshika Hong LGA
11. Construction of road at Wuro-Jebbe Yola South, among other presentations.

TOWN HALL MEETING II:

A town hall citizen engagement with his Excellency the Executive Governor Adamawa State Rt. Hon. Ahmadu Umaru Fintiri on 2021 Budget was held at the Government house banquet hall in Yola on 30th July, 2020. The Meeting is in line with State Fiscal Transparency, accountability, sustainability requirements (SFTAS). This engagement was necessary in order to assure the citizens that their earlier input to the 2021 budget have been captured before the budget is signed into law by the State House of Assembly any moment before the year end.

OPENING REMARK BY THE PERMANENT SECRETARY STATE PLANNING COMMISSION ALH. USMAN HAMMAN'AD MAPEO.

- I feel highly delighted and honoured on behalf of the Adamawa State Planning Commission to welcome all of you to this Town Hall Meeting on citizen's engagement and citizen's Budget. I wish to applaud the decision of the present administration in taking the process of Budget preparation down to the local community level to enable

the people at the grass roots have a say in the areas they want government to intervene and make them benefit from the dividends of democracy.

AN OVERVIEW OF ADAMAWA STATE 2020 BUDGET AND 2021 PROPOSED BUDGET BY THE EXECUTIVE CHAIRMAN, STATE PLANNING COMMISSION DR. MARY PANINGA,

- Your Excellency, this afternoon your citizens, representatives from different parts of the State are here in fulfilment of the requirement of SIFTAS on participation of citizens in the budget process and ensuring their inputs have been captured and the confidence that they are being carried along. Your Excellency, the citizens which are the ultimate pride of your decisions in Adamawa State are all around today.
- One might ask, what is **citizen budget**?
- **Citizen budget** is a document that summarizes and explains basic budget information in line with transparency and accountability of his Excellency's administration, so that the citizens will now hold Government accountable in that aspect. It is a kind of report

presented to the people in an acceptable format using a clear language that they can understand.

- The citizen budget is first of its kind in this year's administration of his Excellency, we have it both in Hausa and English Languages contained in one booklet, a sample is this one of 2020.

WHY DO WE NEED THE CITIZENS BUDGET?

- Your Excellency, the citizens budget is written in an accessible language for the citizen to have a thorough understanding of how the budget affects their lives, it also explains how the money is being managed.

As your Excellency is aware, the State Planning Commission has the mandate to do that, and by the law establishing the State Planning Commission in section 5 and 6 which clearly spells out the function of the Commission as:

- To determine and advise on policies that will best promote unity among all citizens living within the state.
- To enhance the efficiency of the public sector spending and general state economic management.
- To ensure social justice and human welfare at all levels of the society
- To draw up from time to time, state economic priorities and programs and map out implementation strategies.
- To provide a state focal point for the coordination of state policies and programmes.
- To focus on key state development issues and suggest ways for their efficient resolution.
- To advice the Governor in all spheres of State life.
- To provide policy advice on development plan of the State to the Governor.
- To monitor projects and progress.

It is on this backdrop that the State Planning Commission ensures such avenues are constantly created to keep the citizens informed of happenings in the developmental facets of the Government.

The citizens may as well wish to note that the Fintiri led administration is operating a very robust government touching on every aspect of the citizen's lives. This is evident in the areas covered by the 2021 budget which include:

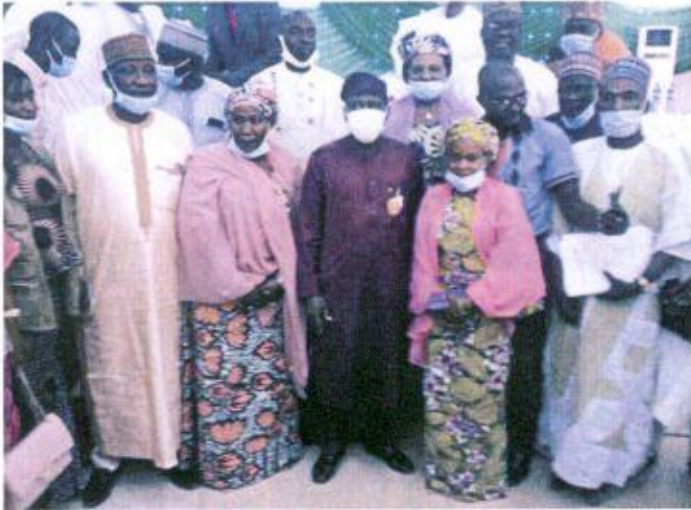

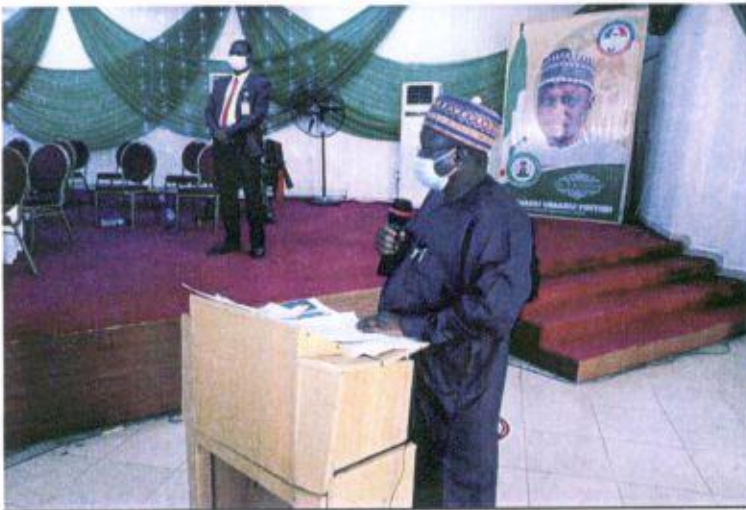
